

## Moving House

Update your address with the following companies: (this can usually be done online)

Aspect of Lifestyle	Company/Organisation	Done?
Home	Gas (need meter reading)	
	Electricity (need meter reading	
	Water (may need meter reading)	
	Internet and TV services — if you are tied to a contract, you should be able to transfer to the new address.	
	TV Licence - transfer to the new address.	
	Council Tax.	
	Royal Mail — consider a redirection of your mail to the new address until everything is changed.	
	Check what days bins are collected from your new home (found on the local council website).	
	Subscriptions, such as streaming services and online retailers	
Financial	Banks/saving accounts	
	HMRC (for tax and national insurance)	
	Home insurance should be transferred or arranged if you don't have it.	
Driving	DVLA (updating your address is a legal requirement)	



	Car insurance – the area you move to may change the price you pay. It will be invalid if you don't advise of the change.	
Health	GP/specialist services. You may need to register with a new GP if you move areas.	
Professional	Professional Body (GMC, RCOG, NMC etc)	
	Employer – should have updated details.	
	Union – if you are a member	

## **Moving Day Essentials**

- Pack Important Documents: Keep essential documents, such as ID, lease agreement, and financial records, easily accessible during the move.
- Final Walkthrough: Before leaving, do a final check to ensure all appliances are off, and take photographs of meter readings.
